Icons Among Us: Jazz in the Present Tense PROGRAM 9 - Friday, February 12, 2:30 p.m., The Church USA, Feature Documentary, 2009, 93 min

Ken Burns' monumental *Jazz* (2001) was breathtaking in scope, but it almost entirely ignored the music as it evolved past the 1960s. *Icons Among Us* shows that jazz in the 21st century has never been more alive, more vibrant. Capturing scores of performances (sometimes guerrilla-style) in small rooms, local venues, jazz clubs and performance halls throughout America and Europe, this unforgettable film shows not only the astonishing breadth and world popularity of 2000's jazz—from The Bad Plus and Ravi Coltrane, to the daKHAH Hip Hop Chamber Orchestra—but also that the basic elements remain the same. How the "loop" between jazz musicians and the audience is utterly authentic and extremely powerful, and how a simple riff can become something completely different in the hands of widely diverse musicians.
